

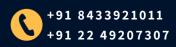

Objective

Develop the skills and competencies of SME bankers in the main management domain of an SME focused bank. The course will highlight the differences between SME Banking and Wholesale Banking or Retail Banking and discuss the product and relationship management challenges for this market. The training will review all the management domains required to manage an SME bank including sales & marketing, products and services including risk and relationship based pricing, risk management (credit, market and operational) and the compliance constraints that influence the SME Bank activities.

The participants will gain a deep understanding of how to maximize the performance of the bank and develop the SME market profitably. We will discuss key success factors and challenges and suggest tools and methodologies to enhance the effectiveness of the SME bankers.

The Programme Features

Lending to SME customers presents one of the greatest opportunities for commercial banks to pursue growth and profitability; at the same time it ties up a large amount of economic capital and represents substantial credit risk.

Taught by an internationally experienced banking executive, this course is designed to give delegates a comprehensive overview of how to build and implement a successful SME banking strategy and how to raise the performance of their institution. It applies to banks in developed and emerging markets. The course will teach you how to use the planning process to set goals, to control costs and to increase the profitability of clients.

The course focuses on the needs of SME customers, defines their product requirements and discusses efficient client relationship management. In addition, it trains on successful sales channel management, optimised client relationship management approaches, the introduction of new products and service. The concept of relationship based and risk adjusted pricing using appropriate risk costs, under economic capital constraints and hence with RAROC and EVA performance focus, will be discussed in case studies and workshops.

This programme draws on the knowledge and practical experience of an internationally experienced executive who has worked for some of the largest institutions in the world and supported large and small financial institutions as a management consultant.

The course will give hands-on examples of how to create value by implementing efficient credit decisions and creating up to date rating and scoring systems. Through examples the programme shows how qualitative and quantitative ratios are applied to examine the credit worthiness of clients and transactions. Finally, participants will assess the main risk factors in SME banking; they will learn how to mitigate these risk factors and how to use an effective portfolio management.

The training will use teaching methods based around lectures, case studies, practical exercises and class room discussions. The course will use real life case studies and examples to develop delegates' understanding of all aspects of SME banking, client management and risk management issues.

Participants will learn to apply the key principles of successful SME banking to different real life situations and adopt an action plan for their own institutions.

Course Instructor - CLIVE WYKES



Born in Belgium Clive is of British nationality. He was raised and educated both in England and Belgium, where he graduated from the University of Louvain (UCL) in Belgium, with a Masters in Applied Economic Sciences.

From 1973 to 1991 he developed his career in banking with American Express and Chase Manhattan Bank. During those years he covered many areas of banking of which credit and marketing, risk management, product development and management, budgeting / MIS and strategic planning as well as

general management. He was exposed to local and international markets in Retail Banking and Corporate Banking (SMEs, large global corporations and Institutional). He had management responsibilities at departmental level and General Management responsibilities included CEO - Country Manager Chase Belgium and EMEA Sales Executive Risk Management Products.

In 1991, he founded a Management Consultancy firm, PI Consulting SA Belgium, and developed his business with large European financial institutions. In 2008 he founded BC&T Ltd in Mauritius to take over the consulting and training activities of PI Consulting SA, Belgium and focused primarily on emerging countries and banks, while maintaining his activities in Europe, the Middle East and Asia. He has had consulting mandates with banks such BNPP, AXA, Barclays, Soc Gen, FNB, BBS and many more. He has collaborated with large solution vendors (Teradata, CSC, SAS...) in risk management, compliance and IFRS solution design as well as client valuation and management solutions. A substantial part of the consulting with solutions vendors and integrators was for retail banking solutions and retail bank restructuring. Clive is on the Advisory Board and Executive Board of Sovereign Bank Int'l, St Lucia.

Clive has worked in over 65 countries around the world, with banks and other financial institutions either as project manager in management consulting assignments or as training course director.
